**Audition Window Now Offered Through Nov. 17**

LITTLE ROCK— If you love singing Christmas carols, consider singing with Top of the Rock this holiday season. Top of the Rock Chorus, Arkansas's premier women's four-part harmony a cappella chorus, is inviting interested female singers to audition on any Tuesday night beginning on Nov. 3, and continuing until Nov. 17, at 7 p.m. at Woolly Auditorium at the Arkansas School for the Blind, 2600 West Markham, Little Rock. No advance preparation is necessary, but the ability to read music is a plus. Participants should be able to maintain their vocal line during harmony singing. They will receive a free voice evaluation to determine which part is best suited for them, and free singing lessons throughout the audition period. They will also be invited to sing with the chorus at public concerts on Dec. 5 and 6. There is no obligation to attend future rehearsals or pay for any instructions.

For the last 30 years, Top of the Rock Chorus has consistently placed among the top five in its region and qualified for international competition six times. The chorus has just returned from International Harmony Classic competition in Nashville, Tennessee, where it placed second in the world in mid-size chorus competition.
